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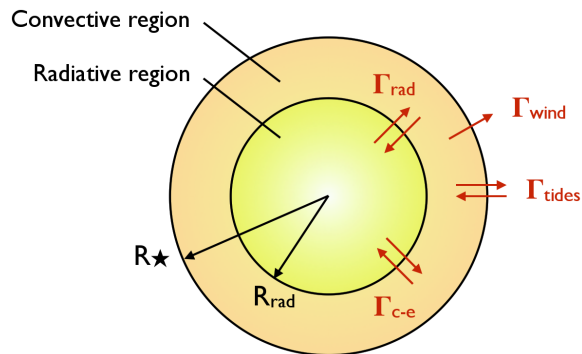
About Me

I am a postdoctoral researcher CNES fellow at IPAG in Grenoble since January 2018.

My favourite topic is the rotation of low-mass stars (0.4-1.2 M) and more specifically the modelling of all the physical mechanisms involved in its evolution.

These mechanisms are:

- wind : the stellar wind that extract angular momentum from the stellar surface
- disc : the star-disc magnetic interaction
- $\text{c-e} / \text{rad}$: the internal redistribution of angular within the stellar interior / evolution of the internal structure
- tides : the impact of the planetary migration on the stellar rotation
- And other external torques
