
About Me

I am a postdoctoral researcher CNES fellow at IPAG in Grenoble since January 2018.

My favourite topic is the rotation of low-mass stars (0.4-1.2 M) and more specifically the modelling of all the physical mechanisms involved in its evolution.

These mechanisms are:

- Γ_{wind} : the stellar wind that extract angular momentum from the stellar surface
- Γ_{disc} : the star-disc magnetic interaction
- $\Gamma_{\text{c-e}}/\Gamma_{\text{rad}}$: the internal redistribution of angular within the stellar interior /evolution of the internal structure
- Γ_{tides} : the impact of the planetary migration on the stellar rotation
- And other external torques
